## INSTRUCTIONS.

(1) Application forms received by Hecruiting Oficers will not be handed hack aguin to applicanta, bat will be passed direct to the Medical Practitioner, who will similarly return them to the Recruiting Officer, whow will then forward them by post to the Officer in Charge of the Central Recruiting Depott to which recruits are instrueted by them to report.
(2) If an Applicant who has been rejected desires a copy of this certificate, it must be completed in duplicate at the time of Medical Examination, and the word "original" or "duplicate," as the case may be will appear on top of the reapective forms. Both copies will be forwardid to the Oticer in Ghurge of the Cehitral Recruiting Depot, where the duplicate will be impressed with the official stamp and then retorned to the Applicant.
(3) Copies will NOT be made of any certificates of acceptance. The word "Duplicate" will be struck out of such certificates, and they will be sent to the Officer in Charge of the Central Recruiting Depôt by post.
(4) Names of accepted applicants who do not report at Central Reeruiting Depôt within the preseribed time will be forwarded to the local Recruiting Oficer for information.

(6) Only thoese persons who fulfil the requirements in all other respects will be examiand regarding medieal fitneas. These requirements may be ascertained by reference to daily newapapers and official posters.
(7) The Central Recruiting Depōt to which accepted applicants from various places will be wont for final medical examination will be determined by District Cotrumandants. Recruiting Oflicers at outlying placer will require to isaue clear instructions to such applicants informing them where and when to report, and will forwani the application forms in time to ensure that they will be in the hands of the Ollicer in Charge of the Central Recruiting Depôt when the recruit reports for enlistment.
